A person with a disability is placed in a job in a community business which best suits his/her abilities and preferences. Training is provided on the job site in job skills and work related behaviors, including social skills by a job coach. As the employee gains skills and confidence the job coach gradually spends less time at the worksite. Support is never completely removed. The vocational services agency furnishing the job coach is always available to the employer for re-trainings, assisting with dealing with challenging behaviors, supplying periodic consultations, and providing flexibility for change. Our goal is to work with various community providers to give optimum service and support for enriching the quality of life of the individuals we serve.
